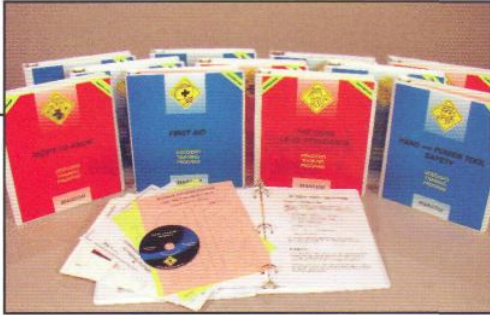

KITS, DVDs AND VIDEOS

The DVDs and videos in the Construction Safety Series are all available as part of safety meeting and regulatory compliance "kits". Each general safety kit contains a DVD or video, 5 posters and 30 employee booklets... all designed to work together. Most regulatory compliance kits also contain a compliance manual with a complete "fill-in-the-blank" written compliance program. Regulatory kits are available with either full-length "initial training" DVDs/videos or "refresher" DVDs/videos.

DVDs, videos, posters, booklets and compliance manuals are also available separately. Each DVD/video is attractively packaged in a three-ring binder along with a comprehensive leader's guide, quiz, scheduling and attendance form, and training certificate. Brightly colored posters can be placed on construction trailers, walls and in other areas for maximum impact. They catch employees' eyes and remind them to "Think Safety!". Booklets are available in packages of 15. Text and illustrations review the important points on the corresponding DVD/video's topic. All booklets are 16 pages in length.

INTERACTIVE CD-ROM AND ONLINE COURSES

"Construction Safety Series" programs are also available as interactive CD-ROM and online courses. The CD-ROM versions of the courses are Windows compatible and include a free learning management system (LMS) that has comprehensive scheduling and recordkeeping capabilities. Each course comes with complete Trainer's and User's Guides. The online versions of the courses are available through MARCOM's Online Training Center or can be run on an in-house SCORM-conformant LMS.
